WHERE: GBN CTE lab classrooms

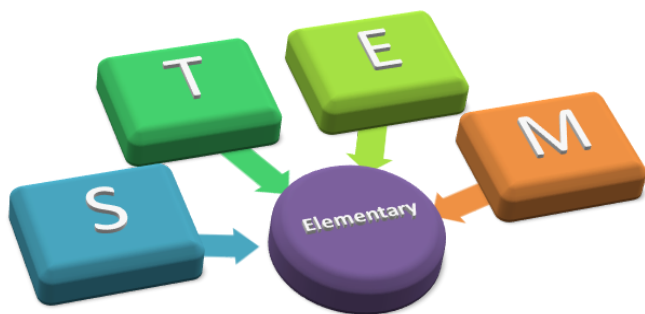


Students **must** be present IN PERSON for both days of the camp
